YOU SAID: Reports of a local Cannabis Factory

WE DID: A drugs warrant was issued on an address on Rugby Road, Hinckley. Following a search of the address a very well equipped cannabis factory was discovered in the loft of the property. Plants and a large amount of cannabis leaf was hidden away, with the latter ready to be sent out onto the streets.

Officer estimate on the drug find was in the region of £10,000.
A male was arrested at the address with the investigations still ongoing.
