OPERATION SCEPTRE

Operation Sceptre is a nationwide week of action tackling knife crime and focuses on the following activity –

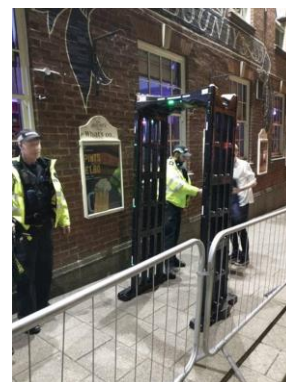
- Pursuing and Prosecuting those involved in this type of crime.
- Preventing people from engaging in this type of crime.
- Protecting people from being impacted by this type of crime
- Preparing Officers to be able to actively target this type of crime.
- To identify, disrupt and educate the community about knife crime and the dangers.

Police officers on night time economy patrols in Hinckley Town Centre took our knife arch and knife wands and with the full support of the management of some of our main NTE venues including Bounty, Out Out, Revival and Evisca and ensured that all customers entering passed through the arch or by a knife wand as a condition of entry to make sure that no weapons were being carried.

No items of concern were found and we received many positive comments. Our thanks go to the premises for supporting us on the night and helping ensure that Hinckley Town Centre remains a safe place to come for a night out.

Local Parks were also targeted, with proactive high visibility patrols at 11 in the area of Hinckley and Blaby. Knife wands were carried in order to make searching for any hidden weapons a lot easier.

No weapons were found on our patrols, however 1 park visited led to several people running off and those that were caught were searched and found to be in possession of small amounts of cannabis!



Proactive work from the team #YouSaidWeDid:

YOU SAID: Concerns regarding increased drug dealing/ASB around Edward St, Hinckley.

WE DID: NH26 & NH25 Beat Team Officers executed a warrant at an address on Edward St after ongoing reports of drug dealing and ASB affecting local residents. The alleged perpetrators were understandably 'surprised' by the visit and an amount of cannabis, drug paraphernalia was recovered at the property. The perpetrator involved was invited for interview at Hinckley Police Station. A positive result! Enquiries are still ongoing but is a warning to anyone that actively deals in the area, We are watching you!
