ST GEORGES DAY – Saturday 23rd April 2022

I am writing to advise you that to accommodate our St Georges Day Event and Scout parade in Hinckley between 10am and 2.30pm on Saturday 23rd April, we have a temporary road closures in place.

There will be a 'Road closed' sign at the road entrance to Market Place between 8am and 4pm, this is to allow for safe set-up/breakdown, to accommodate extra stalls and to prioritise pedestrian safety during the event. The pedestrianised area of Castle Street does have a road closure in place during the event but as vehicle access to this part of Castle Street is only allowed between midnight to 10am and 4pm to midnight this will not affect any deliveries/access made before or after these times.

The scout parade is due to leave St Mary's playground on Station Road at 1.15pm, they will form up by using St Mary's road, and this road will be closed from approximately 12.30pm whilst this happens until the parade has safely left the area at 1.15pm

The following roads will be closed between 1.15pm and 2pm to allow the scout parade to safely pass through their route. It will be a rolling road closure so once the end of the parade has safely passed the road will be open, each road will be temporality closed and traffic held for 5 to 10 minutes:

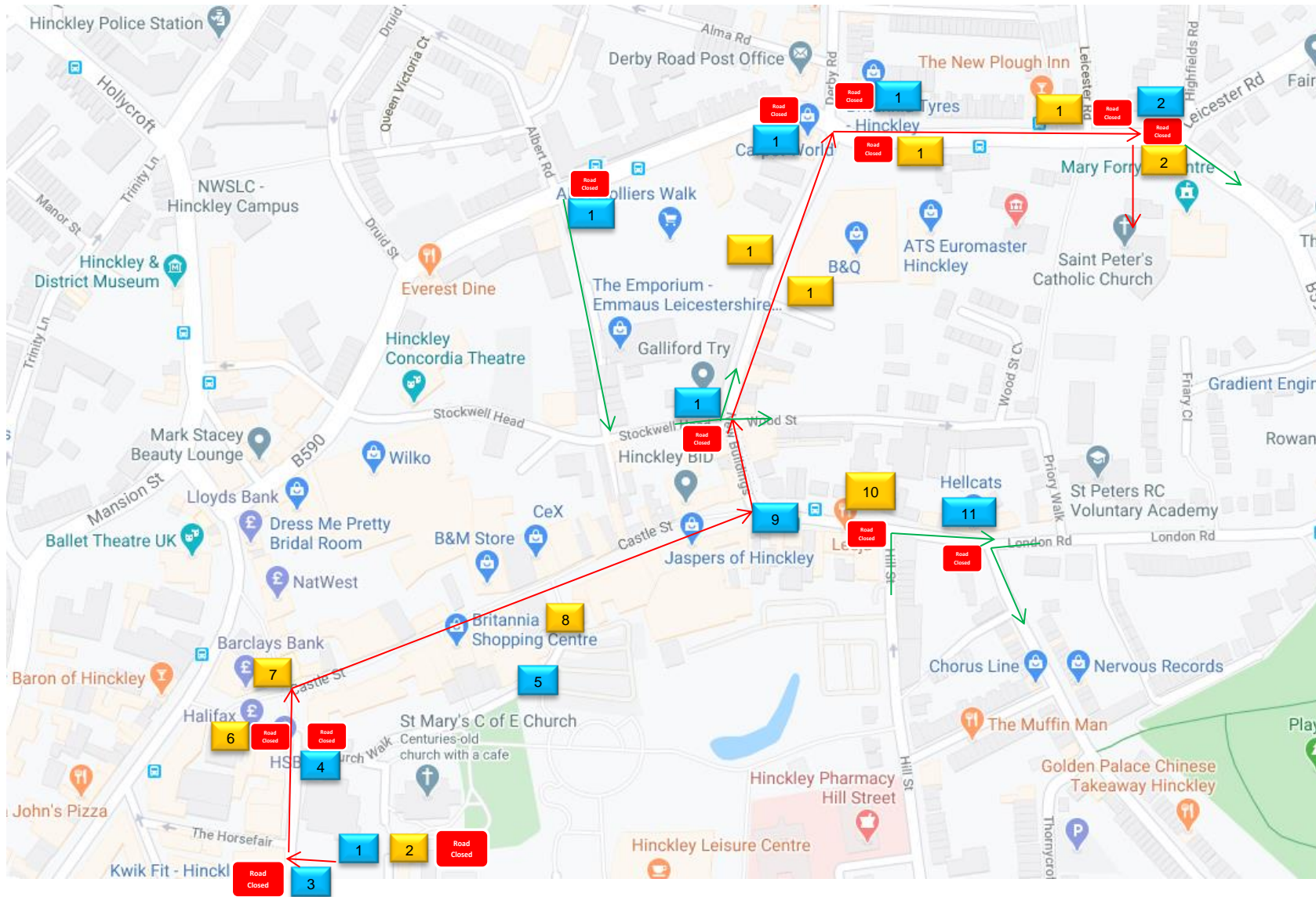
Station Road from junction of The Horsefair to Marketplace
Castle Street from Market place to junction of Hill Street
Church Walk Entire length
New Buildings Entire Length
Leicester Road the junction of Derby road to St Peters Church
St Marys road from junction of Argents Mead to St Marys school

Please ensure all staff/residents see this letter so they are fully aware of the road closures in place, as this may affect them getting to and from work. I hope that this will not cause you too much inconvenience, please be patient as the parade involves around 500 young people and their safety is paramount. Please see reverse of this letter for a detailed map of the parade route.
